## 1. DATES

The event is being held from 26<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> May 2018 at the Coniston Sailing Club. There will be racing each day with up to 7 races over the weekend.

## 2. ENTRY

Entries will be accepted for dinghies and Flying Fifteens. Unfortunately we cannot accommodate multihulls or Sports Boats.

Entry costs will be:

Double handers (2 crew)	£35
Single handers	£25
Juniors (single or double)	£20

There is a £5 discount for Coniston Sailing Club members. For all others, temporary membership is included in the price.

The price includes all three days racing and the social events, but it does not include food, drink or accommodation.

All competitors will be required to sign the entry forms. Juniors must have their forms signed by a parent **or an adult responsible for the junior**.

## 3. DIRECTIONS

Coniston Sailing Club is on the shore of Coniston Water on the edge of the village.

The best Postcode to use for your SatNav is LA21 8AS. This gets you to our approach road, marked X on the diagram below. Follow the road down and you will see the club.



Someone will help with where to leave your boat(s) and then will direct you to the Car Park.

## 4. BOAT PARKING

The boat park will be available from 8.00am on the Saturday morning until Monday night.

As far as possible, please do not bring your cars into the club area, or leave them unattended anywhere other than the Car Park except while unloading.

Dinghies will be parked on the beach or in the main dinghy park. Please leave your boat where requested.

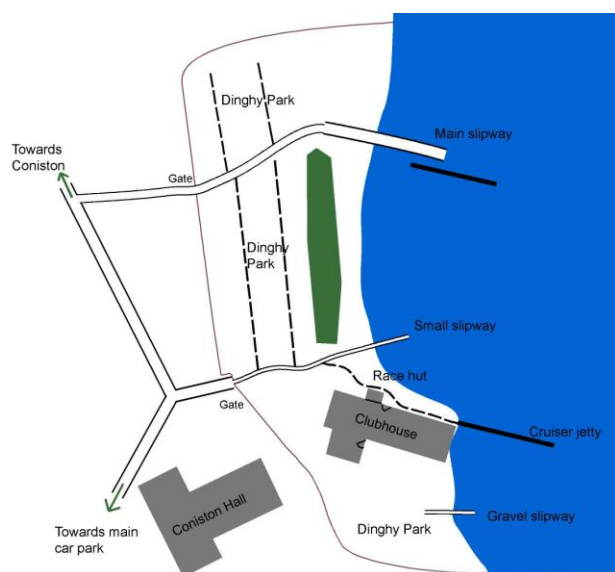
Flying Fifteens must be launched from the main slipway. Between races they may be put on moorings or rafted at one of the jetties, you will be told what to do. There will be safety boats available to get you out to your boat (and back).

## 5. CAR PARKING

Please park your car and any road base as directed by our helpers. During your registration you will have opportunity to borrow a barrier keyfob (£5 returnable deposit).

## 6. THE SAILING CLUB

The map below shows most of the important parts of the club.



Inside the clubhouse there are male and female changing rooms and toilets. A drying room will be available, this is at the end of the main room. There is a large kitchen area, where food will be served. The bar will be open during the weekend and will be the centre for social events.

Outside, on the south side of the club, is a barbeque area, which will be available on the Saturday/Sunday evening.

## 7. FOOD AND DRINK

The bar will be open at normal licensing hours throughout the bank holiday weekend.

Breakfast (bacon rolls and drinks) will be served on Sunday and Monday from 09:30.

Lunch will be available 12:00 each day.

Cake stall available throughout the regatta (whilst stock lasts).

**If you are attending and will be at a loose end, help is always welcomed in the kitchen.**

There will be a barbeque where you can cook your own food on Saturday/Sunday evenings.

A chip van has been booked for the Sunday evening.

There is a small farm shop at Coniston Hall, which is good for ice creams and small items. There are a number of pubs and restaurants in Coniston, which is a short walk away. As it is Bank Holiday weekend, you may well wish to book ahead.
